In this role, Mendonca will be responsible for management of PNGC Power’s long-term resource planning, as well as acquisition for procuring, integrating, transmitting and managing purchased power supplies, including the establishment of rates and pricing. Mendonca will also oversee new generation resources for PNGC Power’s Members, 14 Northwest electric distribution cooperative utilities with service territory in seven western states.
